

# Noe Noa

*I assume that you have a basic knowledge in crocheting, this is a very easy scarf. If you need help, there are web pages that will teach you the basics :)*

You need:

2 balls of cotton yarn, like Mandarin Petit (180 m/50g)

Crochet needle size 3,5 mm

Crochet needle size 1,75 mm

Beads (I used 4mm)

Make 17 ch st. Now turn and make one dc in the third st from the needle. Continue making dc in every ch st, total of 15 dc st. Turn, make 2 ch st and continue making dc st over the 15 dc st from the last row. Continue crocheting dc st rows for about 45-50 rows.

Now crochet dc st over only the next 5 dc st. Make 5 rows, then dc st over only 3 dc st for 10 rows. Cut thread and pull through last stitch

Now continue with the 10 dcst for 5 rows. Divide again, and crochet 5 rows with only 5 dc st. Then continue over only 3 dc st for about 10 rows. Cut yarn and pull through stitch. Continue now with the 5 dc st left, crochet 8 rows, then only 3 dc st for about 10 rows before you cut yarn and pull through stitch again.

You have now made the first half of the scarf. Start making dc st rows from the other end and make the other half (make it as long as you prefer)

Flowers: With crochet needle size 1,75 mm, make 6 ch st and join to make a ring, make 10-12 sc around the ring. Make 3 ch st, and 1 sc in the second st from the needle. Continue making a total of 5 loops. Now, in each loop (flower petals) make 1 sc, 1 dc, 2 tr, 1 dc, 1 sc. Fasten yarn, and sew to scarf with a bead in the middle.

I like the scarf more after it has been washed, in the machine, and then tumble dried. That gives it the look that I like, and it gets much softer.
